DIY BALLOON ROCKET

For home-balloons who also like adventures

1. Inflate a balloon and tape a straw to its side, so that both ends are sticking out. (For best results, clamp the balloon with a binder clip instead of tying it.)



2. Decorate your balloon for the adventure it's about to go on.

> 3. Tie a string across the room. Make sure it's tight and not too close to any furniture. (Thread the string through the straw before tying the ends.)

4. Release the clip (or untie the knot), and let it fly! If you can't undo the knot, have an adult pinch the balloon above the knot and cut the knot off completely.
